User Manual

POWER ON & BLUETOOTH MODE

- Switch on the speaker.
- The device will automatically enter Bluetooth Mode.
- On your smartphone or music device, turn on Bluetooth and search for the speaker model name.
- Select it to pair. Once paired, the device will automatically reconnect when turned on subsequently.

Controls in Bluetooth Mode:

- ►|| (Play/Pause): Short press to play or pause music.
- ◀◀ (Previous): Press to go to the previous track.
- ▶▶ (Next): Press to go to the next track.

TWS (TRUE WIRELESS STEREO) PAIRING

- Power on two identical speakers.
- On one speaker, press and hold the MODE (M) button for 5–10 seconds.
- A tone will indicate TWS activation.
- The second speaker will also give a tone once the connection is successful.

Note:

TWS works only in Bluetooth Mode.

USB / TF CARD PLAYBACK

- Insert a USB flash drive or Micro-TF card (up to 32GB) into the slot.
- The speaker will automatically detect and start playing MP3 files.

Controls in USB/TF Mode:

- ►|| (Play/Pause): Short press to play or pause music.
- ◀◀ (Previous): Press to go to the previous track.
- ▶▶ (Next): Press to go to the next track.

AUX-IN Mode

- Connect an external device using the AUX cable.
- Press the MODE (M) button to switch to AUX Mode.
- Note:**
- In AUX Mode, track control (Next/Previous) must be done from the connected device, not from the speaker.

CHARGING THE SPEAKER

- Use the **original charging cable** provided with the speaker.
- Connect it to a **DC 5V/2A USB Adapter**.
- A **Red LED indicator** will turn on while charging.
- Charging time via 5V/2A Adapter **Approx. 3–4 hours**.

BATTERY BACKUP

- Wireless Mode: Approx. 6–7 hours at 50% volume.
- USB Mode: Approx. 6–7 hours at 50% volume.

ACCESSORIES INCLUDED

- Charging Cable – 1 piece
- Aux Cable – 1 piece
- Wireless Microphone – 2 piece

SAFETY & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Use only the provided charging cable for best performance.
- Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the speaker yourself.
- Keep away from water, heat, and strong magnetic fields.
- Disconnect the charging cable once fully charged.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker not turning on	Battery drained	Charge the speaker for at least 30 minutes before use
Bluetooth not connecting	1. Device not in pairing mode 2. Already connected to another device	1. Restart speaker & enable Bluetooth mode 2. Disconnect other devices and re-pair
No sound after connection	Volume too low / muted on device	Increase the volume on both speaker and connected device
USB/TF card not working	1. Unsupported format 2. Card not properly inserted	Ensure files are in MP3 format and re-insert the card/USB drive
AUX-IN not playing	Loose cable connection	Check the AUX cable and reinsert securely
Speaker not charging	1. Faulty cable 2. Power source issue	Use original cable and try another power adapter/USB port
TWS not connecting	1. Speakers too far apart 2. Wrong procedure	Keep both speakers close, and repeat pairing steps

Red light: Charging"

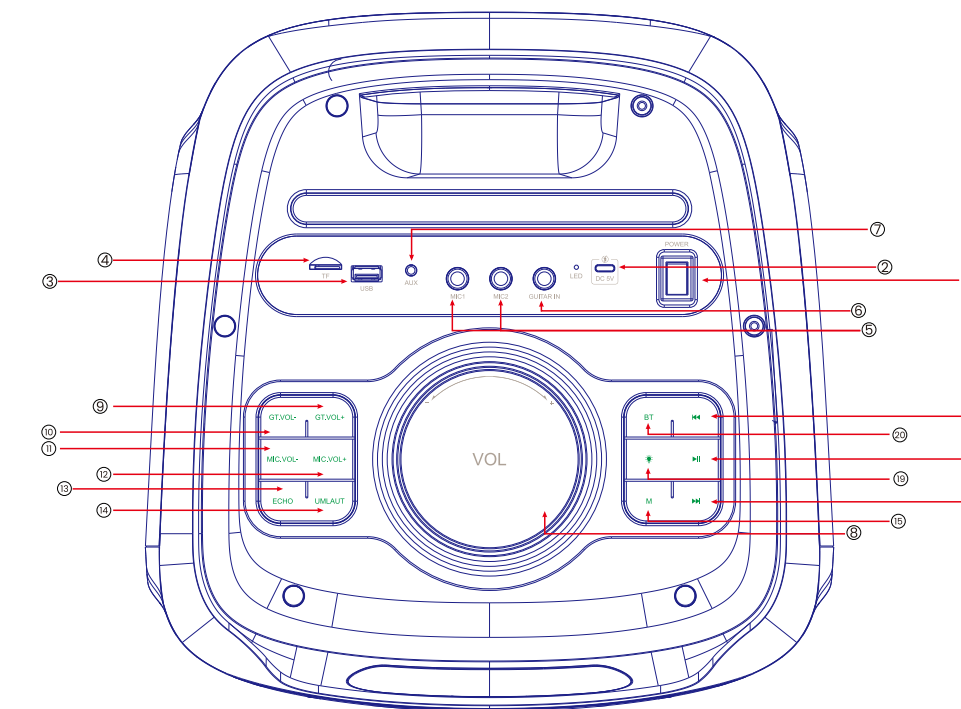
2 Mute Button/Power Button

Mute Button: Press to mute the microphone
Power Button: Press once to turn the microphone ON/OFF"

3-Battery Cover

Unscrew the lower cover to access the battery compartment. (Built-in 18650 Li-ion battery inside, please don't exchange the battery with engineer) When low battery, Please use charging the microphone with original charging cable"

Note: Replace both batteries at the same time.
Do not mix old and new or different battery types.



1. POWER : To turn ON/OFF the speaker.
2. DC 5V: Plug charging cable to the speaker and connect other end USB port to the power source. (Support fast charging)
3. USB slot: Used to read the Mp3 files in FAT32 format with maximum size of 32GB.

4. TF slot: Used to read the Mp3 files in FAT32 format with maximum size of 32GB.

5. 6.35mm MIC jack: MICROPHONE-IN

6. 6.35mm Guitar Jack: Guitar-in

7. AUX: 3.5mm Aux-in jack

8. VOL: To adjust the master volume

9. GT. VOL-: To turn down the guitar volume

10. GT. VOL+: To turn up the guitar volume

11. MIC VOL-: To turn down the MIC volume

12. MIC VOL+: To turn up the MIC volume

13. ECHO: To Increase/Decrease Echo

14. UMLAUT: To select MIC effect.

15. M: To change or select mode. Long press to active TWS

16. Play/Pause: Under USB/TF/Bluetooth mode, short press for play and pause;

17. PREV: USB/TF/Bluetooth mode: Press to move previous track.

18. NEXT: USB/TF/Bluetooth mode: Press to move next track.

19. Light: Press to select light mode.

20. BT: Press to reset BT mode.
